

## **ABOUT ADAMA POLYTECHNIC COLLEGE**

The start history of Adama Poly Technic College as an educational institution could be traced back to Emperor Haile Sillassie when he laid the foundation stone in 1939, by giving "Nazareth Primary School" as its first name. The last sixty nine years (69 years) of advancement towards its present college status has witnessed several significant transformations. By adopting "Gelawdiwos'as its second new name the expansion of the school continued up to grade eight in the 1940's. Later on with the help of some public funding, the school was able to open grade nine in 1952. In the following years it became a comprehensive secondary school and reached a stage enabling some 64 students to sit for grade 12 National Examination in 1955.

It will not be an exaggeration if one assumes the "conception" of Adama Technique College began in 1976 and became operational with the technical and personnel assistance from the Soviet Union (USSR). However, the integration of vocational training and academic streams under the same management body has no doubt created some acute administrative problems. To solve this problem, an attempt was made in 1971 for the technical separation of the two different streams by giving the name "Hawas Secondary School "and "Adama Tegbareid Technical School ". In 1994-95 further administrative modification was made by assigning two school directors for each stream in one and the same school compound. In the academic year 2000, the academic section (better known as preparatory) is detached from Adama TVET College and The College become one of the leading TVET colleges in Ethiopia.
